Background:

Mr. Hurwitz joined the Port Authority of New York in 1963 and was a member of the design team responsible for the development of Newark Airport and the World Trade Center. He joined the architectural firm of Paul Rudolph in 1967 and headed design teams responsible for several large projects including the design of the Southern Massachusetts Institute of Technology, the Burroughs-Wellcome pharmaceutical research facility and the Orange County Government Center. He joined the architectural firm of Marcel Breur and Associates in 1970 and was involved in the design of the student center for the University of Mass. and the IBM headquarters in Boca Raton, Florida. Mr. Hurwitz has been practicing in the Mid-Hudson region since 1972 and has designed many of the major buildings to be built in there as well as designing projects in Africa and the Caribbean.

Relevant Experience:

Mr. Hurwitz has been the recipient of many industry awards. He was the winner of the "Japan Architect" housing competition and his design for the Amsterdam City Hall was exhibited at the Reiks museum in Amsterdam Holland. He has been cited for his achievements by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and in 1992 was responsible for winning the competition for the design of the new YMCA in Kingston, N.Y. Mr. Hurwitz was eight times awarded the "Best Building of the Year" award for structures built in Orange, Ulster and Sullivan Counties (N.Y.) and in 1993 and 1994 he received the award for "Best Corporate Structure". He has lectured at S.U.N.Y. College and was a guest lecturer at the Mitsui Cultural Institute in Kyoto and Osaka, Japan. His works have been published in major foreign and domestic journals and in several books on architecture.
